- 3) Clear opportunity for harbours to unlock social & economic potential
 - Regional priorities
 - Existing versus new harbours
 - Linkages with other economic and social development initiatives important to achieve full benefit

4) Governance important:

- Structures
- Transparency
- Bottom up interest

5) Consider maintenance / development and operations

- Multiple role-players
- User committees
- Management structures
- Constitutional / mandate issues to be clarified

6) Must spend available budgets on priority harbours

- Identify funded priorities
- Launch detailed planning and implementation
- In consultation with users and affected parties
